

# Our Philosophy

The educational philosophy of CHRIST FOR AFRICA UNIVERSITY (CFAU) rests on its commitment to be of service to the body of Christ through the spiritual equipment that could resist heretics of this empty generation. The Center focuses the students to a life and a future already integrated with the real working world. With this theory in education, CFAU then dedicated itself to the molding of future professionals in attaining, a dream, to take an active role in the education and training of the students, workers, professionals through continuous innovation of education program and evaluation of ministry needs.



### STATEMENT OF FAITH

- A. We believe the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired Word of God (Exodus 24:4; Psalms 19:7-10; Luke 24:44; Matthew 5:17-18), without error in the original writings (Deuteronomy 4:1-2), the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of man, and the divine and final authority for all Christian faith, life, and conduct (2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21).
- **B.** We believe in one God (John 10:30), Creator of all things (Genesis 1:1), infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19).
- C. We believe that Jesus Christ, without any change in His eternal deity (John 10:31-38; Hebrews 1:3), became man through conception of the Holy Spirit and virgin birth (Luke 1:31-35), that He died on the cross (Mark 15:23-26; John 19:16-18), a perfect and complete sacrifice, in our stead and for our sin according to the Scriptures (Hebrews 9:13-15; Ephesians 1:6-7). He arose bodily from the dead and ascended into heaven (1 Corinthians 15:3-4; Acts 1:6-11) where, at the right hand of the Majesty on High, He is now our High Priest and Advocate (Hebrews 2:16-17).
- D. We believe that the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:13-14) and, during this age, to convict of sin and regenerate the sinner upon belief in Christ (John 16:7-12; Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 6:11); at the time of regeneration baptizing the believer into the one body of which Christ is the head (Galatians 3:26-28) and to indwell, guide, instruct, fill, and empower the believer for godly living and service (Romans 8:26-27 & 15:13; Proverbs 3:5-6).
- E. We believe that man was directly created by God in His own image (Genesis 1:27), but fell into sin (Genesis 3). The entire human race is, therefore, lost and only through repentance (2 Corinthians 7:10), faith in Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:4-9), and regeneration of the Holy Spirit, can salvation and spiritual life be obtained (Romans 8:13-14).

### STATEMENT OF FAITH

F. We believe that the atoning death of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only ground of justification and salvation for all who believe (John 14:6; Acts 4:12), and that only such as receive Jesus Christ by personal faith are born of the Holy Spirit and by Him sealed to the day of redemption (Ephesians 4:30).

G. We believe in the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ (2 Timothy 4:1), and that the hope of His appearing has a vital bearing on the personal life and service of the believer (2 Timothy 1:8-10).

H. We believe in the bodily resurrection of all the dead (Romans 8:11), of the believer to everlasting blessedness and joy with the Lord (Romans 4:7-8), and of the unbeliever to judgment and everlasting and conscious punishment (Matthew 25:46; Hebrews 10:29).

I. We believe that the Church is composed of all such persons who, through saving faith in Jesus Christ, have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit and are united together in the body of Christ, of which He is the head (Romans 12:4-5; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13).

J. We believe that water baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances to be observed by the Church during this present age. They are, however, not to be regarded as a means of salvation (Matthew 28:19; Acts 18:8; 1 Corinthians 11:23-29).

**K.** We believe that all the saved should live in such a manner as will honor and glorify and not bring reproach upon their Savior and Lord, and that it is commanded of God to remain separate from false doctrine, sinful pleasures, practices, and associations (Ephesians 5:25-27; 1 Peter 2:11).

### Programs – Certificate and Diploma

#### <u>Certificate Program - EDUCPT Bible Courses</u>

Certificate programs are short term courses in various areas of studies. Certificates are awarded upon successful completion of a certificate program

Credits from completed Certificate Program(s) may be transferred into a degree program.

#### <u>Diploma Program - 6 Modules</u>

Credits from completed Diploma Program(s) may be transferred into a degree program.

#### Associate Program - 8 Modules

Associate programs are provided in association with our National and International Partners. Associate degrees are issued directly from our international partner universities.

Credits from completed Associate Program(s) may be transferred into Bachelor's degree program.

### Programs – Bachelor's degree

Bachelor's degree Program - 11 Modules Must be completed in 3years.

Credits from completed bachelor's degree Program(s) may lead to a Master's Degree program.

# Programs – Master's degree

Master's Degree Program - Must be completed in 2 years.

#### Master's degre programs include

- •Master of Biblical Study 4 Modules
- •Master of Ministry Pastoral Missions Counseling <u>4</u> <u>Modules</u>
- •Master of Religious Education Christian 5 Modules
- •Master of Divinity (M.Div.) 8 Modules
- •Master of Theology (Th.M.) (6 Modules = prerequisite - Master of Divinity)

Credits from completed Master's Program(s) may count towards to a Doctorate Degree Program.



# Programs – Doctorate degree

All Doctoral Program must be completed in 4 years



# Programs – Doctorate degree

Doctorate degree programs are as follows:

Doctor of Ministry (D.Min.) - <u>4 Modules</u> + dissertation <u>module</u> Doctor of Religious Education (D. R.Ed.) - <u>5 Modules</u> + dissertation Doctor of Theology - (Th.D.) - <u>5 Modules</u> + dissertation module

For a doctorate program, a student must complete 4-6 module credits beyond the Master's level. In addition, the student is also required to complete a dissertation of at least 120-150 pages. When the student has finished his/her academic modules or approved course material and defend their thesis they will receive a Doctorate of Ministry Degree. A Master's degree is required to enroll in this program.

Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) - 6 Modules + dissertation writing module

When a student completes 6-9 credits beyond the Master's level, completes and defend s a dissertation of 25,000 words and above, a <u>Doctorate degree in Theology and Religion</u>, <u>Religious Education</u>, or <u>Homiletics</u>, will be conferred.

A Master's degree is required to enroll in a doctorate program.

# Programs – Doctorate degree

Doctor of Divinity (D.D.) - 4 Modules, and/or 15 yrs. ministry + dissertation writing

When a minister has completed at least 15 years ministry experience and willing to comply for evaluation as well as write his/her Ministry Project, and /or completes at least 24 - 36 units home study assignments, the **Doctorate of Divinity can be conferred**. Those with less than 10 years in the ministry may need a 36 - 48 credit units depending on their ministry evaluation.

Transfer of credit is not accepted into the Doctoral program. All doctorate course work must be done through the Institute. The only exception applies if student who already holds an earned doctorate. In that case, the student may earn a Ph.D. by completing only 36 - 48 credits through the Institute.

Failure to complete the year of study will result in One Year Remedial Classes.
